



BALLROOM AND LATIN AMERICAN AMATEUR STATUS  
AND PROMOTIONAL POINTS SYSTEM  
AMENDMENT

The following resolution was passed at a Council Meeting of the SADTA held on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2009.

“In the case of a section being danced as a straight final i.e. 7 couples or less. The points awarded for each placing will be worked out by awarding the last place (i.e. 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> place) 5 points and increasing by 5 points per higher placing.  
e.g. A section comprising of 3 couples, points will be awarded as follows:

3<sup>rd</sup> place ..... 5points  
2<sup>nd</sup> place .....10points  
1<sup>st</sup> place ..... 15points

At least 3 couples must have competed in the section for points to be awarded. Where age groups are combined due to too few couples in a section, points will be awarded according to the result of the combined section.

COUPLES CHANGING AGE GROUPS:

Beginner, Bronze, Silver, Gold & Novice.

Couples status will remain the same and retain the accumulated points in the next age group.

Pre- Championship & Championship

May be re-graded one grade lower (couples option – once decision is made they cannot change) No points will be retained from previous age group.
